Dear all,

Per the below action item for me to draft a response to JTC 1 N 11243. The two national body proposals took different approach with the Japanese recommending the current draft unchanged and the US recommending a change in the question and minor adjustment to the appendix F. But the rationale of the US proposal was to make general improvement of the form and directly related to the comments from SC36. The question was changed because it should be assumed that there is still a great deal of unknown about the content during new work proposal stage. Instead of asking for “known accessibility requirements and dependencies”, one should consider whether the proposed work may directly impact individuals. The language in the US proposal for appendix F reflects the same timing issue as identify in the template question.

Since the rationale for the divergent between US and Japanese proposal is rather different and that I do not believe the rationale behind the US proposal is unacceptable to others, my recommendation is to start with the US recommendation for the purpose of the plenary call. We can discuss and determine if we want to accept, modify, or reject the US proposal during our discussion.
